

SUSPENSION OF A TEST FACILITY FROM
THE NATIONAL GLP PROGRAMME

The Suspension of a Test Facility (TF) from the National GLP Programme would be considered during a given cycle of certification, if:

- 1) Major deviations from GLP Principles have been observed during inspection(s) and duly recommended by inspection team.
- 2) TF is not considered suitable for award of GLP status when evaluated for renewal of GLP status.
- 3) TF has failed to attend to major deviations / deficiencies observed in previous inspections.

The decision to suspend a TF will depend on inspection reports which establish that the TF is not operating in compliance with GLP Principles.


The inspection reports will be examined by the Technical Committee which may either endorse the recommendations of the inspection team or request for some more information or may advise for a verification inspection.

If the Technical Committee recommends suspension, the recommendation will be sent to the Chairman, NGCMA for a final decision. The decision for suspension will be communicated to the TF by Head, NGCMA.

The TF may appeal against the suspension of TF from GLP programme to Head, NGCMA as per Document "Appeal Procedures of National GLP Compliance Monitoring Authority" (GLP-108).

Status quo of the TF with respect to GLP compliance status will be maintained till the decision on the appeal is taken. If the decision to suspend the TF from the National GLP Programme is upheld, the date of inspection would be considered as the date of suspension.
